Indirect discrimination		When an employer or organisation does not make appropriate changes to make the needs of disabled people easier	
Direct discrimination		When someone is treated worse than another person in a similar situation because of disability	
Failure to make reasonable adjustments		Being treated badly because of something connect to a disability, such as having an assistance dog or needing time off for medical appointments	
Discrimination arising from disability		Treating a disabled people badly because they have made a complaint of discrimination	
Harassment		When someone treats a disabled person in a way that makes them feel humiliated, offended or degraded	
Victimisation		When an organisation has a particular policy or way of working that has a worse impact on disabled people compared to people who are not disabled
